



## **CONSCIOUS SEDATION WITHOUT LICENSED INDEPENDENT PRACTITIONER (LIP) COMPETENCY**

1. A physician or LIP 's order is needed for this procedure.
2. An RN must have ACLS or equivalent certification to perform this procedure.
3. An RN may not give the initial dose of moderate sedation in the absence of a physician or LIP.
4. The Med Surg RN may redose moderate sedation.
5. The Sedation policy does not apply to patients on the death and dying protocol.
6. The administration of moderate sedation by a RN in the absence of an LIP is limited to situations where the RN is accompanying a patient traveling to/from a diagnostic area.
7. A notification report using the MIDAS system must completed if a reversal agent is used.
