



PHYSICAL ASSAULT/WORKPLCE VIOLENCE (For CNA - Psych Only)

TRUE or FALSE

1. All incidents of assaultive behavior involving patients and employees in the workplace are reportable to management and law enforcement agencies.
2. Physical assault means inflicting harm or injury to another person which is not accidental by nature.
3. Any act of physical aggression against any individual in the work area is considered workplace violence.
4. Fascination or involvement with weapons is a precursor to violence in the workplace.
5. An employee who is constantly angry, argumentative and paranoid must be carefully monitored for potential "violence".
