



SEXUAL ASSAULT/RAPE

TRUE or FALSE

1. Legal definition of rape in most states is "forced vaginal penetration".
2. Rape is primarily a sexual crime to achieve sexual gratification.
3. Collection and preservation of the chain of medico-legal (forensic) evidence is an integral part of medical care for sexual assault victims.
4. Law enforcement officers need not sign any document upon receipt of forensic evidence.
5. Crisis intervention is the primary therapeutic approach to management for rape victims.
6. Proper forensic documentation should be done prior to medical treatment, unless injuries are life threatening.
7. Only rape victim have the right to determine whether or not to report sexual assault to law enforcement.
